Open call conditions

Deadline for open call applications – 1st of June

1. Open call conditions

1.1 Eligibility to apply: The applications to partake in the Clear Space exhibition may be submitted by professional artists of various fields, who were born in Lithuania, Latvia, Estonia or those, who have lived in these countries for more than 3 years.

1.2 Works to be submitted: No fewer than 3 artworks by the same author and no more than 3 photographs of each artwork may be submitted Clear Space exhibition selection.

1.3 Work evaluation: 5 to 7 authors from each country will be selected. The artworks will be evaluated by an international team of curators, made up of experts and partners from glass art fields. The decision of the committee will be final and indisputable. All authors will be informed about the selection personally by e-mail before July 1st, 2020.

1.4 Artwork presentation: Authors, using their personal funds, organize the transportation of the artworks to the exhibition (to a location in Lithuania, disclosed by the project organizers) and back. The delivered artwork must be identical to the one presented in the application.

1.5 Deadlines: The selected artworks must reach the organizers before September 14th 2020, to the following address:

1.6 Insurance: The insurance of the artworks during the transportation and exhibition period is sorted out by the author.

1.7 Copyrights: The selection organizers have the right to publicly announce the personal details (name and surname) of the participants, which are directly related with the competition. The organizers assure, that the data protection and legality of handling of the received personal data will be enforced with all necessary and justifiable means.

1.8 Photographs of the work: Photographs, submitted for the competition, may be publicized in printed and electronic publications, internet websites, while crediting the creator and abiding to all copyright laws.

2. Requirements for artworks and their accompanying information in the open call application.

2.1 The artworks, submitted for the selection, must be mostly made of glass, including video art, installations and objects.

2.2 The exhibition is meant for unique glass creations (works of industrial design cannot participate in the selection). Drawings and sketches of the artwork are not accepted for selection.

2.3 The artworks must be created from 2017.

2.4 Photographs sent in for selection must be high resolution (jpeg. format, not smaller than 300 dpi), suitable for both the selection and catalogue printing, photographed clearly, in a neutral background. The file name must contain the last name of the author and the name of the artwork (Last Name_Name of the artwork.jpg).

2.5 Every artwork submitted for the selection must be clearly identified. Mandatory information is as follows: Name and last name of the author, name of the artwork (in Lithuanian and English), dimensions, material, technique, year of creation.

2.6 The application form is filled out in Lithuanian or English.
